DESCRIPCIÓN:

This project „Frystak through the eyes...” will take place in small town Frystak (3.500 inhabitants) near Zlín in Czech Republic. Base (accommodation) for participants will be the scout base „Eliška“ in beautiful setting by a wood near the town Frystak. The main topics are: Active participation of young people, Creativity, Youth free time and Intercultural dialogue and learning. The aim of project is to create international teams, which are dealing with a particular topic: Art, Music, Dance, Juggling, Documenting, Rope activities, Yoga and Massage. This teams will prepare thematic workshops, that will extend and enrich offer of the festival Fair Play. The project involves a five-member groups from these countries: Turkey, Romania, Croatia, Bulgaria, Spain and of course Czech Republic (Youth directly from the venue). The number of participants is 30. The project is designed so, that after getting to know each other, all participants will engage in prepared workshops. Next they create teams, which are deeply involved in a specific topic and next they will prepare thematic activities for participants of festival Fair Play. The team, which focuses on the topic “Documenting” will create video-document, mapping festival Fair Play and activities and workshops of the others teams. Participants will also meet with local children and youth (target group of festival Fair Play) in the visit of basic school and free-time afternoon club. Project will also permeate other topics, like: national prejudices, European citizenship, European cooperation.

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DESCRIPCIÓN:

Citizenship can be fun! project will host 32 young people and 8 group leaders from 8 countries in July 2013 for an 8-day long youth exchange in Székesfehérvár, Hungary. The exchange raises the question: how can we, the citizens foster the creation of a long-term happy and sustainable European society? During the exchange participants will focus on the four founding concepts of Gross National Happiness: cultural values, good governance, natural environment and sustainable development. Each concept gives a day a topic, when we work with it and take a look on how citizens can foster it. Also, we find a way to take action for each in the local context and practise to be active citizens. The exchange will be composed of BOCS Foundations interactive global education activities, simulation games, field volunteering combined with loads of space for creativity and self-expression when we build on the input of participants and group leaders and enjoy the benefits of the different points of views and backgrounds of the mixed intercultural group.

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DESCRIPCIÓN:

30 teenagers and 6 leaders from three countries, Poland, Bulgaria and Spain, will actively participate in the project on developing tolerant and fair attitudes to cheering sport heroes. Initial activities will focus on the integration meetings online friends making, cheering experience exchange, preparing fan gadgets and accessories, exchanging experience on fan culture. The meeting of the parties in Poland and the participating in the planned activities will be an inspiration to the careful observation of the problem of unfair and violent rooting and, in a broader context, of the intolerant attitudes, xenophobic behaviour, contrary to the standards of social coexistence. A number of cheering events during various sport competitions, workshops with the police and a psychologist are supposed to help deeply understand the problem and familiarize the participants with the phenomenon of unfair cheering. Furthermore, during the meeting, the participants are going to take part in sport competitions and events themselves to promote fair play on the sport grounds and the stadium stands. They are going to take part in fan poster competition among the students of schools in Sanok, an exhibition of the best posters to give the project a local dimension. Information about the project will be presented on the school blog and in the local newspapers and on TV. The participants are going to make a graffiti on fair cheering near the biggest football stadiums in Cracow to make the project's activities visible. The aim of the project is to develop attitudes of tolerance, enhance openness, and a healthy competition and also to make the participants realize the legal and social consequences of xenophobia, incompatible with the norms of social coexistence behaviour and criminal deeds..

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DESCRIPCIÓN:

The main activity of project "Ideas are no birds" will be a ten day long training course that will be held in July 2013 in Latvia. During the training participants will gain skills in idea and brainstorming methods, innovative presentation and publicity methods as well as gain insight in actual problems of youth field in different countries. The other part of training will allow participants to practice newly gained skills and try to find practical solutions for typical topics of youth organizations/projects. Namely, finding ways for involving disadvantaged youth, creating effective support systems and platforms for exchange of experiences among youth project organizers and facilitators, as well as improving motivation of youth project participants' to get involved in follow up activities of international youth projects. After the training participants are expected to exchange their experiences in implementation of created solutions in their daily organization work/youth project(s).
